

## Post-Graduate News

Courses of instruction in medical and surgical subjects are arranged from time to time as the opportunity occurs, and may be attended by any medical practitioner, though a slightly higher fee is payable by those who are not Members of the Fellowship of Medicine. Detailed syllabuses of each course are prepared as soon as possible, and if post-graduates will notify the Fellowship of Medicine (1, Wimpole Street, London, W.1) of the subjects in which they are interested, their names will be entered on the appropriate mailing lists to receive copies, without charge, when published.

### CARDIOLOGY

Out-patients clinics every Tuesday and Wednesday at 10 a.m. Tickets can be obtained from the Fellowship of Medicine, price 25s. for 10 attendances, or 2s. 6d. for single attendances.

### ANAESTHETICS

#### OXFORD: Department of Anaesthetics, Radcliffe Infirmary

Tuition is available for any period from one week upwards, consisting of as much teaching as the ordinary hospital routine will permit. Only two post-graduates may attend at any one time. Fee, Members of the Fellowship of Medicine, £3 3s. od. for one week, and £2 2s. od. for each consecutive week after the first; to non-Members, £3 13s. 6d. for one week, and £2 2s. od. for each consecutive week after the first. Occasional Intensive Revision Courses each of two weeks' duration, are given during the year, and while these Courses are in progress the above-mentioned tuition will be suspended. Applications must be made to the Fellowship of Medicine, *not* to the Radcliffe Infirmary, Oxford.

**LONDON:** Revision courses of two weeks' duration, are arranged from time to time. Lectures every afternoon at the Royal Cancer Hospital; practical demonstrations every morning at various general and special London hospitals. Fee, to Members of the Fellowship of Medicine, £7 17s. 6d.; to non-Members, £8 8s. od.
