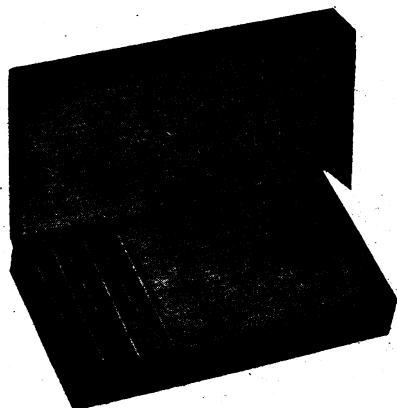
St. John's Hospital for Diseases of the Skin,
