GRANULES

In the majority of cases, even in saddle-nose associated with the collapse of the columella, this wedging is an adequate support for the nose, improving the airway considerably, but it could if necessary be supplemented by a columella strut, i.e. implantation of a sliver of bone about 1 in. long between the lower end of the graft and the spine of the maxilla.

Whatever method may be used in the treatment of either recent or old fractures, nothing short of a satisfactory airway and a normal cosmetic result should satisfy. This is the least that should be

expected from those whose duty it is to deal with the problem of the broken nose.

### Summary
