Electrocardiography: an audiovisual approach to ECG interpretation

The package is made up of two lectures associated with the appropriate slide. The first lecture covers the basis of the ECG terminology, and the appearance of the normal ECG. It also covers the mechanics of bundle branch block, and deals with the appearances of myocardial infarction and ventricular hypertrophy. The second lecture is devoted entirely to cardiac arrhythmias.

These lectures are intended for medical students, junior doctors and nurses in coronary and intensive care units. These groups of people need instruction in basic cardiography, and the aim of the package is to allow them to educate themselves as and when the need arises. Although the information contained is much the same as that in 'ECG Made Easy' by using an audiovisual approach it has been possible to improve the quality of the illustrations considerably, and to produce them in full colour.

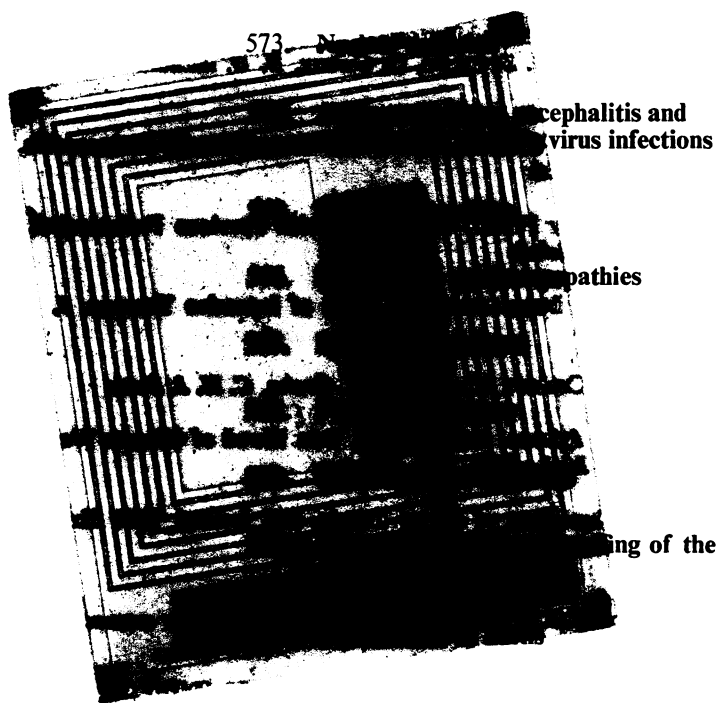
