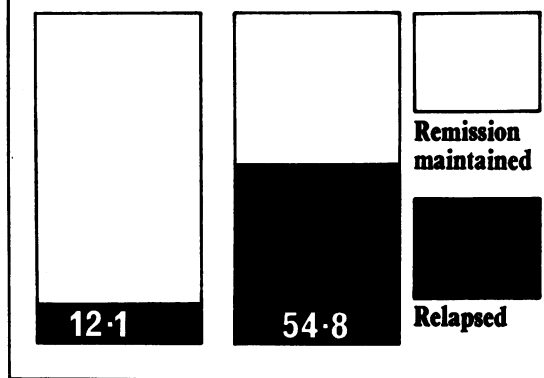

“It is concluded that maintenance treatment of ulcerative colitis with sulphasalazine (salazopyrin) should be continued indefinitely unless contraindicated by side effects”¹
