REPORT OF THE HONORARY SECRETARIES
FOR 1930.

THE following is an account of the activities of the Association during 1930. It is gratifying to report that the number of post-graduates has greatly increased and the total number of tickets taken for all courses is the largest on record.

During 1930, 642 post-graduates availed themselves of the General and Special Courses, as compared with 606 in 1929 and 506 in 1928.

The following analysis specifying the nationality of the post-graduates shows the international character of the work of the Fellowship of Medicine.
