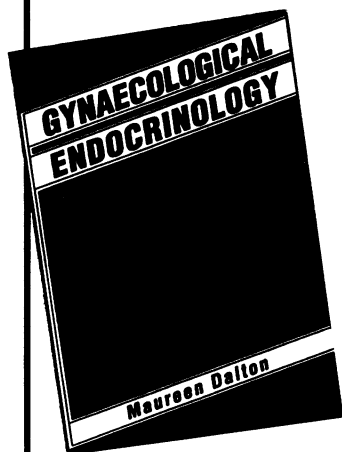

The complaint is taken as the starting point and the causes, relevant points of history and examination, investigations and possible methods of treatment are then covered.

This book provides paediatric and medical oncologists, paediatricians and internists with a detailed description of the recognised long-term complications, a discussion of factors that are known or suspected to increase the risk or severity of a particular complication, and recommendations for monitoring patients at increased risk of a particular complication.

### AIMS AND SCOPE

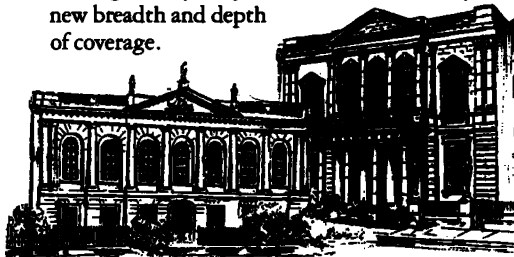
